CPA Member of the Year Award 2006

Dr. Sinclair is the Chair of the CPA Committee on Ethics and has been for a number of years. In this capacity, Carole responds to requests regarding ethical issues from CPA members and the public, provides information to governments and other organizations related to ethical matters and the Canadian Code of Ethics for Psychologists and coordinates the CPA ethics complaints process. In addition, she is completing an on-line course on ethics for CPA which will be ready in early 2006 and she has revised the document that compares the CPA, APA and ASSPB codes of Ethics. She has published numerous journal articles and has spoken extensively at national and international conferences on ethics. She is preparing a CPA Web-based course “Being an Ethical Psychologist.”

Her last article published (with Alan Okros) was in *Psynopsis* of “The Canadian Code of Ethics and the Dark Side of Interrogation” (Spring 2006).

Carole has served the CPA in a variety of other functions, including serving twice as a member of the Board of Directors, CPA Secretary-Treasurer (1993 - 1996) Member of the CPA Executive (1991 - 1993) Chair of the Committee on Sections (1991 - 1993) Chair of the Committee on Continuing Education (1990 - 1991) and Member, Editorial Board, *Canadian Psychology* (1988 - 1993).

In 1987, Carole won the CPA Applied Division award for Outstanding Contributions to the Application of Psychology to Human Problems.

Carole is Director of Treatment Services and Quality Management with The Hincks-Dellcrest Centre in Toronto and runs a private practice.
