The Clinical Psychologist works within a comprehensive and integrated mental health system. The Psychologist functions as a member of a multidisciplinary mental health care team to provide services that promote wellness and provides timely interventions that support and empower patients to achieve their highest level of functioning. Some of the activities that can be expected include:

- Lead and participate in the development, and instruction/counseling during group sessions for anxiety, PTSD, depression, stress management;
- The provision of clinical leadership and consultation to mental health staff in the provision of mental health care to patients;
- Administer full range of diagnostic tests for psychometry assessment, interpret results, and prepare psychological evaluations;
- Report results and interpretations of tests, interviews, and evaluations to the multidisciplinary team;
- Assist in the identification, development and evolution of mental health programming;
- Participate in program orientation and provides information to external inquiries as required.

Clinic hours of operation are Monday to Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Calian offers flexible types of employment including full-time and part-time opportunities for employees and independent contractors. There are no overhead costs or management challenges that are typically associated with private practice.

### **Mandatory Qualifications**

- Must be a graduate of an accredited University with a Doctoral Degree in Clinical Psychology;
- Must hold a current license within the province of practice;
- Minimum of 2 years clinical experience in a health service institution.
