Candidates must clearly indicate how they meet the following essential qualifications

- Graduation with a Master's or Doctoral degree from a recognized university with acceptable specialisation in clinical, forensic, or counselling psychology or in another psychological speciality relevant to the position;
- Registration for autonomous practice of psychology by the provincial registering/licensing body in the province of Ontario
- Experience in the provision of psychological services (including mental health services), such as assessment, counselling or other psychological services with adults, either to groups or individuals;

General information:

CSC offers a comprehensive benefits package that includes an indexed pension plan, a health care plan, an employer-paid dental plan, a disability insurance plan and generous leave benefits. Doctoral level registered psychologists can earn up to \$ 92,398.00 including salary, a terminable allowance and a penological factor allowance; those registered at the Masters level can earn up to \$86,398.00. Annual membership fees to regulatory bodies are also paid.

If you have a master's or doctoral degree in Psychology, but are pursuing registration, challenging employment opportunities exist within CSC. These opportunities will allow you to apply your skills while under the supervision of registered personnel. Financial assistance for registration-related expenses is available.
