### **Unit Profile**

Pediatric ambulatory care is located in 3F, 2Q and 2G. There are numerous subspecialty acute pediatric services within McMaster Children Hospital. The outpatient service provides acute tertiary and subspecialty medical and surgical care to children aged 0-18 years. It is a dynamic, fast-paced acute care unit where specialized care is provided primarily for children in a family centered environment.

### **Position Summary**

The Psychologist will provide a consultative service to interdisciplinary teams working with patients who are referred for assessment and can provide recommendations related to appropriate interventions. The position will provide services to the pediatric neurology, neurosurgery and acquired brain injury programs. Some knowledge and experience in rehabilitation and treatment issues are required especially related to the neurological populations. The Psychologist should have experience in managing complex patient populations with multiple and dual diagnoses. Relevant care plans may involve individual, family or systemic considerations in conjunction with ongoing medical management. The Psychologist may also be expected to support research opportunities in the context of the interdisciplinary teams as well as provide input to teams regarding program and treatment evaluation. A strong knowledge of assessment, diagnostic issues and treatment interventions is required.

1. Doctoral level training in Clinical Neuropsychology from an accredited university

5. Ability to work flexibly with interdisciplinary teams
