As an integral member of the UHN Rehabilitation Solutions, the responsibilities of the **CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST** include: conducting independent psychological assessments and screens of clients referred to UHN Rehabilitation Solutions from various referral sources; providing a diagnosis; providing as appropriate recommendations for further treatment; developing and communicating a treatment plan to the client, multidisciplinary team, other stakeholders and referral sources; and preparing documentation and formal reports for the referral source; providing treatment and consultations to clients; enabling clients to reach their full functional and work re-integration potential in collaboration with clients, treatment teams and all stakeholders; communicating in written and verbal format to referral sources; participating actively in program planning, development and evaluation; participating in Continuous Quality Improvement activities; participating in approved and relevant academic and research activities of UHN Rehabilitation Solutions; performing cross-functional duties, as assigned or requested; performing other duties consistent with the job classification, as required

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Completion of a recognized PhD degree program in Clinical Rehabilitation Psychology required.
- Two (2) years rehabilitation experience required
- Experience working in within a third party payer environment required
- Registration by the College of Psychologists of Ontario required
- Proof of malpractice insurance required
- Knowledge of adult psychopathology required
- Up-to-date knowledge of assessment of client's with work related injuries, motor vehicle accident claims, mood disorders, post traumatic stress disorder, substance use, and evidence-based interventions required
- Skills in performing psychological tests appropriate for the population required
