Eastern Health is looking for Clinical Psychologists to join our team of dynamic professionals. These areas include addictions, autism, forensic, medicine, mental health, neuropsychology, oncology, pain management, rehabilitation, surgery and women's health. Mental Health and Addictions Program- Child and Adolescent Division, Bridges Program
Permanent, Full-Time

Duties: This position functions autonomously in the provision of advanced, specialized clinical service to teenagers assessed as in-crisis with psychological problems for which an urgent professional intervention is indicated, and who can benefit from a focused, change-oriented intervention. Duties include 1) psychological assessment; 2) focused, change-oriented psychotherapy; 3) systemic intervention; 4) analysis of clinical service and; 5) clinical supervision to psychology interns and provisionally registered psychologists within the Mental Health and Addictions Program.

Janeway Children's Health and Rehabilitation Centre
Mental Health and Addictions Program- Child and Adolescent Division
Permanent, Full-Time

Duties: The primary responsibility of this position is to provide clinical psychology services to psychiatry inpatients and outpatients, (preschool, school age children and adolescents) within the Mental Health and Addictions Program. The position, along with an additional psychology position, provides assessment and treatment, through an interdisciplinary team approach. The applicants should be well versed in psychological assessment, diagnosis and treatment of children with behavioral, emotional, anxiety, learning and other problems. This position functions autonomously.

Community and Children, Mental Health/Addictions, Rowan Centre
Permanent, Full-time

DUTIES: Provides specialized and advanced addictions and mental health services for outpatient/ adolescent addictions clients. Provides a full range of psychological services, including psychological assessments, test administration and interpretation, diagnosis and prognosis, intensive evidence-based psychotherapy and education to individuals experiencing problems with substance abuse and/or gambling and other co-morbidities and /or their families or significant adults. Collaborates with and acts as a consultant to other staff of the Mental Health and Addiction Services program.

**Community Children's Services- St. John's
Intervention Services, Cordage Place
Temporary, Full-Time until May 1, 2011 with possibility of extension**

Duties: Under the direction of the Program Manager, the Psychologist will collaborate with Developmental and Behavioural Practitioners and other members of the Intervention Services team to provide a treatment model that reflects a biopsychosocial perspective of client care in meeting the needs of the parents/caregivers/families of: (1) pre grade one children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (2) pre-schoolers with significant developmental delays, and (3) school-age children with intellectual disabilities who exhibit challenging behaviour. This will include, but not limited to, the administration and interpretation of specialized test batteries; assessment of caregiver and client strengths and needs; planning and delivery of therapeutic psychological interventions as well as group interventions; assessment and treatment of other biopsychosocial factors that impact on the success of clients and parents/caregivers. The psychologist will also participate in research activities and program development, be responsible for clinical intervention, assessment, and perform related work required. The psychologist will provide education/training sessions of a psychological nature to parents/caregivers, clients, staff and other stakeholders; which may include individual mentoring and support, and small and large group events.

Qualifications: Candidates must possess a Master's Degree in Clinical Psychology, Doctorate Degree (preferred). Registration or eligibility for full registration with the Newfoundland and Labrador Board of Examiners in psychology is required. Clinical experience with children and adolescents required.

Salary and Benefits: In accordance with the Association of Allied Health Professionals Collective Agreement and the Newfoundland Association of Public Employees Health Professionals Collective Agreement, salary ranges from \$32.44 to \$41.72 an hour. Eastern Health offers a comprehensive benefits package including 20 days paid vacation, statutory holidays, pension and health insurance plans. Successful applicants may also qualify for relocation expenses. Continuing Education is a priority for Psychology Services and there is funding available to attend local workshops.
