- Develops appropriate clinical training, formal and informal, for graduate students in psychology
- Supervises psychology assistants and psychology practicum and internship students
- Demonstrates accountability for own psychology practice by adhering to established professional practice standards

- Ph.D. in Psychology and Registration with the College of Psychologists in Ontario required with declared competencies in Clinical Psychology with children and adolescents
- Appropriate training in Child Clinical Psychology, preferably from a CPA/APA accredited program
