

**FULL-TIME PERMANENT positions for PSYCHOLOGISTS**

**RICHMOND CENTRE** is a multi-disciplinary mental health clinic with psychiatry, psychology, mental health, nursing and social work practitioners providing a range of therapeutic services for children and adults with mental health problems.

- **FULL-TIME PERMANENT PSYCHOLOGIST** This position is to provide clinical leadership in the area of Dialectical Behaviour Therapy (DBT) and to conduct psychological assessment of Centre clients. This position is responsible for clinical leadership of the provincial DBT Team and the development of further applications of DBT programming for specific populations. The position provides coordination, consultation, and treatment within a multi-disciplinary service involving multiple stakeholders. Interest, training and experience in DBT would be considered an asset.
- **FULL-TIME PERMANENT CHILD PSYCHOLOGIST** The incumbent will be responsible for providing a wide range of assessment, diagnosis, treatment and consultation services working within a multi-disciplinary mental health team operating in the community. Clients will be children, adolescents and their families, presenting with various behavioural, emotional, cognitive, social and systems difficulties. Extensive post-degree clinical experience and training in diagnosis assessment and treatment of children is required.

**QUEEN ELIZABETH HOSPITAL** is a 274 bed multi-service acute care facility. It serves as the provincial referral centre and is home to the Provincial Stroke Unit.

- **FULL-TIME PERMANENT CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST** The incumbent is to provide assessment and treatment to individuals with a variety of difficulties, i.e. stroke and/or mental health patients. This position will be responsible for offering specialized psychological assessments to a variety of patients within the acute care setting including the acute and rehabilitation stroke units. Post-degree clinical experience with stroke and mental health clients would be an asset.

**Qualifications:**

- Applicants must have a Doctoral level degree in psychology and be eligible and registered with the P.E.I. Psychologists Registration Board.
- The successful applicant must have a good previous work and attendance record.
- The successful applicant must provide a satisfactory criminal records check prior to beginning employment.
