

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN COUNSELLING

Applications are invited for a twelve-month term position at the rank of Assistant Professor at the Memorial University Counselling Centre, St. John's, Newfoundland.

Qualifications: An appropriate doctorate in Psychology from a CPA or APA accredited internship is preferred; however, applications from candidates with doctorates in Social Work or other related disciplines will be considered. Registration with the Newfoundland and Labrador Psychology Board, or in the case of non-psychology applicants, other relevant Provincially-regulated profession, is required.

We are seeking a professional whose duties will include group and individual counselling or psychotherapy across a broad spectrum of student concerns, and who has experience in broad areas of mental health. The candidate will have a strong interest in student affairs and student development. The position includes involvement with an innovative interprofessional training program within an evolving interprofessional practice environment. The candidate would be expected to develop programming resources, workshops for, and provide counselling services to, students with disabilities. Experience in outreach activities and interprofessional collaboration would be an asset. Expertise in one or more of the following areas is also important: learning disabilities, autism spectrum disorders, and physical disabilities.

Salary is based on qualifications and experience in accordance with the Collective Agreement between Memorial University of Newfoundland and Memorial University of Newfoundland Faculty Association.

The appointment is effective September 1, 2010, subject to budgetary approval.
