The Department of Psychology at Memorial University of Newfoundland (www.mun.ca/psychology) invites applications for a tenure-track position in human cognition (broadly defined) at the rank of Assistant Professor (VPA-PSYC-2010-001). The appointment will begin on July 1st, 2011, or as soon as possible thereafter. The successful candidate will have a Ph.D. in Psychology, will be able to contribute to teaching courses both within the candidate's area of specialty as well as lower level psychology courses, and will be expected to pursue an externally-funded program of research.

A complete application package consists of (1) a curriculum vitae; (2) a statement of research interests, including selected reprints; (3) a statement of teaching interests and evidence of effective teaching; and (4) the names and contact information of three referees. If electronic submission is not possible, the package should be sent to Head of Psychology, Department of Psychology, Memorial University of Newfoundland, St. John's, NL, A1B 3X9. The deadline for receipt of a complete application is October 20th, 2010. Informal queries are welcomed.
