Key Responsibilities:

As a member of an interdisciplinary team, the Psychologist will provide diagnostic assessments for children, adolescents, and adults with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD). The position requires demonstrated accountability by adhering to established professional practice standards. KPAS is looking for a leader with demonstrated interpersonal and clinical supervision skills with the ability to manage multiple demands.

In line with the KPAS mission, vision and values, the successful applicant will participate in quality improvement initiatives and support the maintenance of a safe and healthy work environment while advancing a culture of client/patient safety through work and daily practices. The Psychologist is expected to participate in continuing education, training, and relevant coursework and have a willingness to conduct research and program evaluation; disseminate information at disability related conferences and through presentations and publications.

Qualifications:

- The successful candidate will have a Ph.D. in Psychology and be eligible for Registration with the College of Psychologists in Ontario. (A candidate that is in the final stages of qualification as a clinical psychologist may be considered).

Appropriate training in Child and Adult Clinical Psychology, preferably from a CPA/APA accredited program is required. Also, the applicant must have:

- Training and experience in assessment and Applied Behavioural Analysis for individuals with Developmental Disabilities including Autism Spectrum Disorders and co-morbid disorders (e.g., psychiatric, anxiety, depression, etc.)
- Knowledge and experience in performing: developmental and psychological assessments including reliable ADOS administration; early identification; parent counselling and consultation
- Knowledge of various treatment modalities (e.g., Behavioural, Cognitive Behavioural Therapy, Solution Focused Brief Therapy, Motivational Interviewing, Interpersonal Psychotherapy)
- Although not a requirement, it shall be an asset for the candidate to possess certification as a behaviour analyst or to be interested in pursuing certification as a behaviour analyst
