## **PERMANENT FULL-TIME PSYCHOLOGIST Mental Health Outpatient Program**

The Psychologist is responsible for offering a full range of client-centred clinical psychology services to clients with acute, and/or severe and persistent mental illnesses in a facility and/or community setting. Working as part of a multidisciplinary treatment team, the Psychologist promotes the role of community treatment and collaborates with community resources to help meet the mental health needs of the individual.

### **Duties:**

- Interview and select clients and administer, score, and interpret a range of psychological tests.
- Screen, plan, and conduct assessments including personality, cognitive, neuropsychological screening or diagnosis, and differential diagnosis.
- Cooperatively develop and implement complex treatment plans especially related to trauma-informed care.
- Provide consultation and advice on diagnosis and treatment.
- Monitor treatment interventions, revise when appropriate, and recommend new approaches to client care when necessary.
- Prepare psychological reports.
- Provide individual and/or group therapy.
- Liaise with community partners to facilitate clients living requirements such as housing, social, and recreational needs.
- Determine need for referral to other professionals or agencies.
- Provide consultation and advice to members of multi-disciplinary treatment team or program management team on developing and evaluating effectiveness of treatment and rehabilitative activities.
- Provide supervision to Psychology residents and practicum students.

### **Qualifications:**

- Ph.D. in Psychology from an accredited post-secondary institution.
- Member in good standing with the College of Psychologists of Ontario.
- Knowledge of the science and practice of psychology including a full range of psychotherapeutic and assessment techniques.
- Knowledge of applicable federal and provincial statutes related to the practice of Psychology.
- Knowledge of community resources, services, and related regulations to make appropriate referrals to community agencies.
- Highly developed analytical skills in determining the most appropriate diagnostic approach from a range of alternatives.
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively within a team of multi-disciplinary professionals as well as independently.
