### Job Summary:

The successful incumbent will be working in two programs (i) Community Mental Health Services & (ii) Autism Support Program. The Psychologists will provide a broad range of psychological assessment and treatment services for children, adolescents and their families. In addition to working in a multi-disciplinary team, the Psychologist will provide clinical consultation to individual Kinark staff and program services.

# As a member of both programs some duties & responsibilities will include:

- Screen and conduct formal mental health psychological assessments
- Delivering individual therapy
- Provide clinical consultation to internal and external stakeholders (e.g. Kinark Staff, Community Agencies & Schools)
- Offer a range of psychological and cognitive assessments for children and youth with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)
- Contribute to the development of treatment plans

#### **Qualifications:**

- A Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology
- Current registration and a member in good standing with the College of Psychologists of Ontario
- Strong clinical assessment and treatment skills in child and adolescent mental health
- Extensive knowledge of ASD and Autism assessment skills with tools such as the CARS, ADOS, VABS
- Demonstrated clinical leadership, proven communication, organizational, and interpersonal skills, and the ability to work effectively as a team member will be significant position requirements.
- Knowledge concerning program evaluation, cultural diversity and proficiency in other languages will be considered assets for this position.
- Travel is required for this position, the successful incumbent must have a valid Ontario driver's license, access to a reliable vehicle and be willing to obtain automobile insurance which includes driving for business purposes with a minimum liability of one million dollars
