These positions involve providing psychological services throughout the English Language School Board as members of the Student Services Team. The Psychologist works in collaboration with the Student Services Team.

Job Responsibilities include the following:

- consultation with school personnel on referrals of children for behavioral, social, emotional and academic difficulties;
- psycho educational assessment of students;
- maintaining liaison with families and with outside agencies providing auxiliary services, crisis intervention support; threat assessment support;
- assisting in the development of educational plans for individuals and groups; individual/group support; providing professional development for school personnel, and supporting other district wide projects.

Qualifications:

- **Permanent Position requires a Master of School Psychology or Clinical Psychology with training, practicum and experience in a school setting and a Bachelor of Education degree;**
- **(Fixed Term Positions require a Master of School Psychology or Clinical Psychology with training, practicum and experience in a school setting and a Bachelor of Education degree preferred);**
- Experience administering psycho educational assessments is required;
- Applicant must be registered or eligible to be registered with the P.E.I. Psychologist Registration Board;
- Applicants will be expected to have a wide range of experience in facilitating change at a school, class and individual level. Experience in an education or clinical setting would be an asset;
- Must have a valid license and access to own transportation.
