Additional responsibilities include triage assessments, crisis

management, and optional supervision of practicum students.

REQUIREMENTS: Masters or Ph.D. in Clinical or Counselling Psychology. Registered or

eligible for registration with the N.S. Board of Examiners in Psychology. Experience providing psychological counselling to adults. Preference will be given to applicants with significant experience providing psychological counselling to international students from a diversity of countries and cultures. Experience at a university counselling center is preferred.
