These positions involve providing psychological services throughout the English Language School Board as members of the Student Services Team. The School Psychologist/Psychological Associate works in collaboration with the Student Services Team.

Duties may include:

- maintaining liaison with families and with outside agencies providing auxiliary services; crisis intervention support; threat assessment support;
- assisting in the development of educational plans for individuals and groups; individual/group support; providing professional development for school personnel;
- and supporting other district wide projects.

Minimum Qualifications:

- **Permanent positions** for a School Psychologist/ Psychological Associate require a) Master of School Psychology or b) Clinical Psychology with training, practicum and experience in a school setting and a Bachelor of Education degree;
- **Fixed Term positions** for a School Psychologist/ Psychological Associate require a) Master of School Psychology or b) Clinical Psychology with training, practicum and experience in a school setting. A Bachelor of Education is an asset.
- Applicant must be registered or eligible to be registered with the P.E.I. Psychologist Registration Board;
- Applicants will be expected to have a wide range of experience in facilitating change at a school, class and individual level;
