

Thames Valley Children's Centre is the regional rehabilitation Centre serving children and youth with physical disabilities, communication, and developmental needs in 10 counties of Southwestern Ontario. We are a community-oriented Centre providing assessment, diagnosis, consultation and therapy. We serve more than 7,000 children, ranging from newborn to young adults, every year. Our research, creativity and innovations have made us pioneers in the treatment and management of disabilities and special needs.

We are seeking a regular, full-time (37.5 hours per week) **Psychologist** in Autism Services. The Psychologist will work as an integral member of the clinical team providing consultation and clinical supervision of staff, and on-going review and evaluation of treatment programs within the Intensive Behaviour Intervention program and ABA-based services and supports for children and youth with ASD. The successful candidate will work from the London office and regular travel will be required within Southwestern Ontario.

## **Responsibilities:**

Under the supervision of the Director and the clinical supervision of the Clinical Director, the Psychologist will:

- Provide consultation and clinical supervision to Clinical Supervisors, ASD Community Consultants and Senior Therapists
- Conduct clinical case reviews by reviewing all information related to client progress (e.g., IBI treatment programs, cumulative data, clinical documentation, assessments and parent reports)
- Participate in Behavioural Assessment and Behaviour Support Plan development and client consultations
- Provide clinical reviews of clients receiving services through the Direct Funding Option and make recommendations for continuation of service
- Provide clinical supervision of psychometric assessment team in relation to program based assessments in IBI and supervision
- May be required to conduct regular adaptive and cognitive assessments to assess on-going progress before, during and after treatment
- Provide strengths-based consultation with families, therapists, community providers, daycares, and schools to collaboratively develop strategies for successful learning
- Participate on agency and community planning committees
- Participate in staff clinical training initiatives

## **Qualifications:**

- Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology from a recognized University
- Registered (or eligible for registration) with the College of Psychologists of Ontario
- A minimum of 2 years clinical experience preferably in Applied Behaviour Analysis and Intensive Behaviour Intervention
- Knowledge of a variety of psychological assessment measures (cognitive, adaptive, behavioural) and curriculums (VB-MAPP)
- Advanced knowledge of child development and the impact of autism on the development of behavioural, communication and social skills in children with autism
- Highly developed interpersonal skills, including written and oral communication
- Flexible, self-motivated, mature consistent approach
- Possess a valid Ontario driver's license and have access to a vehicle
- Good computer skills; familiar with the MS Office Suite 2010 package of programs, especially Word and Excel
- Proficiency in the French language would be considered an asset
