Section Activitie Past Year (2017-2018)	 A call for elections to the Section for Students Executive (Chair-Elect, Undergraduate Student Affairs Officer, Graduate Student Affairs Officer, Communications Officer, and Administration and Finance Officer) was sent out in early February. Results have been announced in April 2018. The new Executives members will join the Section after ICAP 2018. CPA Student Research Grants: This award is intended to support students in undergraduate or graduate programs in any domain or discipline within psychology who are actively engaged in research. We received 34 applications and awarded two \$500 grants (one MA and one PhD). CPA Campus Initiative Grants: The Section has allocated two \$500 awards to fund initiatives from student-run groups or individual students. We received 4 applications this year. Our poster competition for the convention was revamped: instead of allocating one prize for best graduate poster presentation and one prize for best undergraduate poster presentation, we will be allocating one prize for best English poster presentation and one prize for best French poster presentation. We thought this initiative would encourage students to submit abstracts in French for ICAP 2018, held in Montreal, QC. The CPA Student Mentorship Program currently has 24 mentor-mentee dyads participating in the program. Our Section passed a motion to dedicate funds to translating program materials to make it more accessible to all Canadian students, including Francophones. This year, our Section will offer 25 Student Travel Awards (\$250 each) to students travelling to ICAP 2018, based on the quality of their applications. As of April 27, 2018, we have received 18 applications. Our Section published a Fall 2017 newsletter and will soon release its Spring 2018 edition. This year, the Student Representative Program was revamped to allow greater participation from Head Office in communicating with representatives The program cur
