The Development and Rehabilitation Division is an Ambulatory Care Pediatric Service.

Duties:

This is an advanced professional psychology position in the area of child development to the age of 18 years with a focus on preschoolers. This position is to provide clinical psychological assessment, diagnosis and intervention to children who have developmental disabilities and to support their families. The psychologist will be a member of the Development Team, who participates in the diagnosis and support of Autism Spectrum Disorder. Assessment may include work with childcare centres and schools to assist in evaluation of the child. Psychological evaluations include cognitive, psycho-educational and Diagnostic assessments.

Qualifications:

Masters in Clinical Psychology required, Ph.D preferred. Registration or eligibility for registration with the Newfoundland Board of Examiners in Psychology is required. In depth knowledge of child development and the impact of physical and/or cognitive disability on the process of normal development is an asset. Training and supervised experience in assessment, diagnosis and treatment of children is required. A satisfactory record of work performance and attendance is required.

Hours of Work: 75 hours bi-weekly
