Job Summary

The Psychology Section of the Canadian Security Intelligence Service is seeking applications to the position of Psychologist with specialization in Forensic Psychology. The successful candidate will work with a small team of Psychologists on direct and indirect clinical assessments. The chosen candidate will participate in the creation and delivery of training and coaching modules. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to work autonomously for extended periods of time while maintaining productive relationships with other members of the team.

Education

Applicants must possess a Doctorate or a Master's in Psychology and be a member of a Canadian College of Psychologists or of L'Ordre des psychologues du Québec. As part of their graduate studies, candidates should have a degree in Forensic Psychology or must have two (2) years of experience in Forensic Psychology out of the three (3) years of experience.

Experience

Three (3) years of relevant experience after graduate studies in Psychology, including psychological interventions and assessments of youths or adults. Knowledge of such themes as social psychology, psychopathology or socio-cultural issues.

Asset Qualifications

Additional experience in clinical psychology interventions and psychological assessments. Broad training and experience in professional psychology.

Who Can Apply

Canadian citizens eligible for a Top Secret security clearance.

Security Requirements

Candidates must have no criminal record, must not have used illegal drugs in the last twelve (12) months and must be able to obtain a Top Secret security clearance. This process involves a security interview, a polygraph, and a background investigation that includes credit and financial verifications.

Language Requirements

Bilingual imperative (C/C/C).

Salary Range

\$72,010 to \$87,630 per year plus the bilingual bonus. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.
